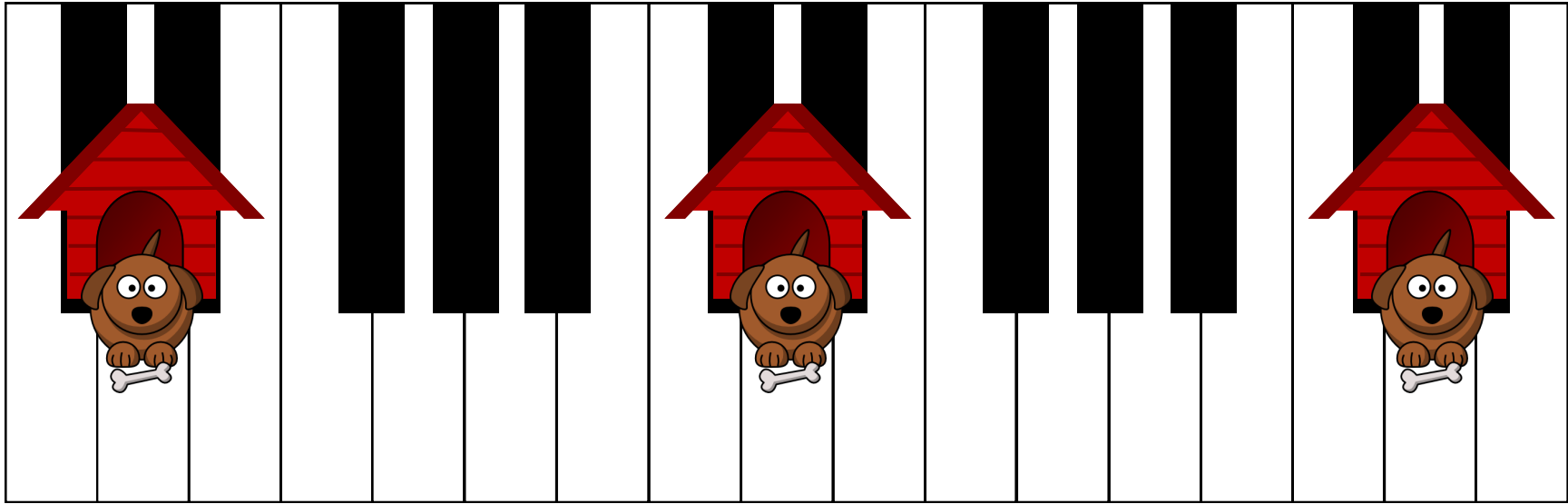


The Dog Song



Play a group of **2 black keys**. Imagine that these are the walls of a doghouse.

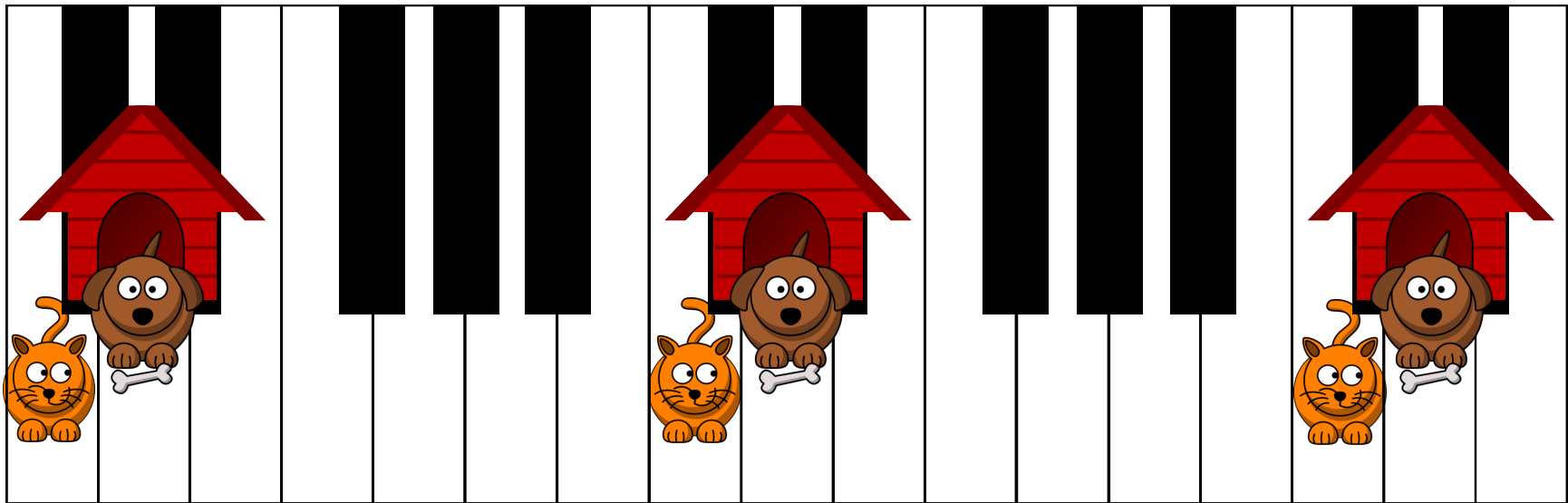
Now, play the white key in between. That's the **dog!**

Find all of the doghouses and dogs on the piano, starting with the **lowest** doghouse and **moving** to the highest. Which dog do you think is the biggest? Can you find a dog that sounds like a tiny puppy?

Now, experiment with different sounds on the piano as you play the doghouse song.

Can you make your dog sound **Sneaky?** **Noisy?** **Sleepy?**

The Dog Song, Part 2



Play a group of **2 black keys**. Imagine that these are the walls of a doghouse.

Now, play the white key in between. That's the **dog!**

Uh oh... look who's sneaking up to the doghouse! Play the white key to the **left** of the dog. It's a **cat!**

Time to play! Imagine that the dog and cat are chasing each other. Use two hands and quickly play the white keys back and forth. Then let your fingers pounce up and down the keyboard, finding all of the dog and cat keys.

Bonus

Can you find all of the D's on the piano? Count how many you find as you play them all **loudly**.

Can you find all of the C's on the piano? Count them as you play them **softly**.
